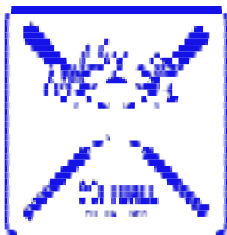


2004 *Bobby Sox* 1A Memorial Day Classic Tournament

ONE (1) PITCH IN ANY INNING CONSTITUTES THE ENTIRE INNING.
THE TEN (10) RUN RULE IS IN EFFECT.
ALL POOL PLAY GAMES ARE UNDER A NINETY (90) MINUTE TIME LIMIT.

In the resulting White Grouping: The Team with a 2 - 0 record will play the team with a 1 -1 record. In Game #4 all pitchers are eligible. If the team with the 2 - 0 record wins Game # 4, this team with the 3 -0 record is the Tournament Champion. If the team with 1-1 record wins Game #4, then Game #5 would be played as both teams now have a 2-1 record. Pitching eligibility for Game #5 would be determined by Game #4. The winner of Game #5 is the Tournament Champion.

PICO RIVERA sm 5 <hr/> Team record 1 - 1 <i>Game 4</i> All pitchers eligible. Flip a coin for home team SUN 10AM D2	PICO RIVERA rl 4 <hr/> Team record 2 - 1 <i>Game 5 -</i> When both teams have a 2 - 1 record. Visitor of Game 4 is home team. Pitching eligibility determined from Game 4. SUN NOON D2

In the resulting Blue Grouping: The first seed of the three (3) teams with a record of 1-1 would be determined on the run differential (RD) for the two (2) games the teams played. Run differential (RD) equals the total runs scored in the two (2) games minus the total runs allowed. The team with the highest (RD) would be first seed and thereby receive the bye and advance to Game #5. If two (2) teams are tied for first (1ST) seed position with the same (RD) then, the team winning in head to head competition would be considered the first (1ST) seed team. The other remaining two (2) teams with a 1-1 record would play Game #4 with the winner playing the first (1ST) seed Team in Game #5 with the winner being the Tournament Champion. In Game #4 and Game #5 all pitchers are eligible.

EXAMPLE: In two (2) games team A scores 10 runs while allowing 5 runs, 10 runs scored - 5 runs allowed = RD of 5.
 In two (2) games team B scores 12 runs while allowing 6 runs, 10 runs scored - 5 runs allowed = RD of 5.
 In two (2) games team C scores 8 runs while allowing 5 runs, 8 runs scored - 5 runs allowed = RD of 3.
 A and C both have an RD of 5, B scored more runs when playing A. Therefore, B receives the bye and is the first (1ST) seed team.
