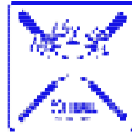
4 Team Pool Play Double Elimination Bracket

After the completion of all pool play games, all play ends when:

If one (1) team has won all their pool play games, and the other three (3) teams have each lost two (2) games, then the team with the 3-0 record is the Tournament Champion.

After the completion of all pool play games, play continues when:

1) RED GROUP. One (1) team has a 3-0 record, and another team a 2-1 record, another team a 1-2 record, and another team a 0-3 record. There shall be no further play for the teams with the 1-2 and 0-3 record. The 3-0 team will play the 2-1 team in the Championship Game. If the 3-0 team wins, this team is the Tournament Champion. If the team with the 3-0 record loses the Championship Game, since both teams now have a 3-1 record, this would necessitate the Ultimate Championship Game being played. The winner of the Ultimate Championship Game is the Tournament Champion.

2) WHITE GROUP. Two (2) teams have a record of 2-1 and two (2) teams have a 1-2 record. There shall be no further play for the two 1-2 teams. The two (2) teams with a record of 2-1 will play the Ultimate Championship Game. The winner of the Championship Game will be the Tournament Champion.

3) BLUE GROUP. Three (3) teams have a record of 2-1, and one (1) team a record of 0-3. There shall be no further play for the 0-3 team. For the teams with the 2-1 record, the first seed, the team that receives the bye, will be determined by their run differential RD which is the total runs the team scored minus the total runs the team allowed in the three (3) games played. If two teams are tied for the first seed with the same RD, the team that won in head to head play will be the first seed. If three teams are tied for the first seed with the same RD, a coin toss will be used to determine the first seed. Any forfeited game is NOT included in determining the RD.

Example A scored 10 runs while allowing 5, RD is 10 - 5 = RD 5

B scored 10 runs while allowing 6, RD is 10 - 6 = RD 4

C scored 10 runs while allowing 7, RD is 10 - 7 = RD 3

In this example, team A would be the first seed with RD 5, team B second seed with RD 4, and team C third seed with RD 3.
