After the first three pool play games in each grouping, if any grouping has all three teams with a 1-1 record, the first seeding will be determined on the run differential (RD) for each team in the two games each team played. The total runs the team scored in their two games minus the total runs scored by their opponents in the two games will determine by the (RD). Example: Team A scored 10 runs and their opponents scored 5 runs in two games, run differential 10 - 5 = RD 5. Team B scored 10 runs and their opponents scored 6 runs in two games, run differential 10 - 6 = RD 4. Team C scored 10 runs and their opponents scored 7 in two games, run differential 10 - 7 = RD 3. Seeding Team A with a RD of 5 would be first seed team, Team B with a RD of 4 would be second seed team, and Team C with a RD of 3 would be third seed team. After using the run differential if two teams remained tied for the first seeding position, the team winning in head to head competition will be placed in the position of first seed team and the other team the position of second seed. If two teams are tied for the second position, the team winning in head to head competition will be placed in the position of second seed, and the other team the third seed.
